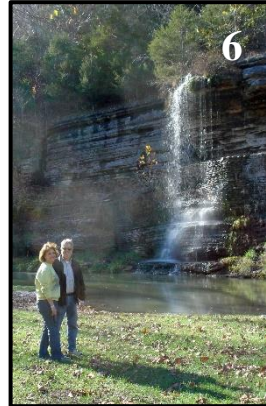
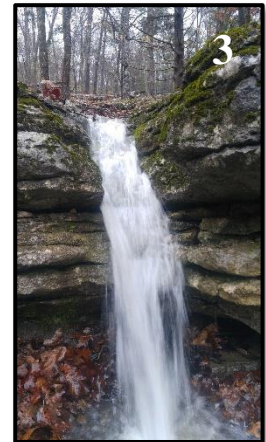


Waterfalls!

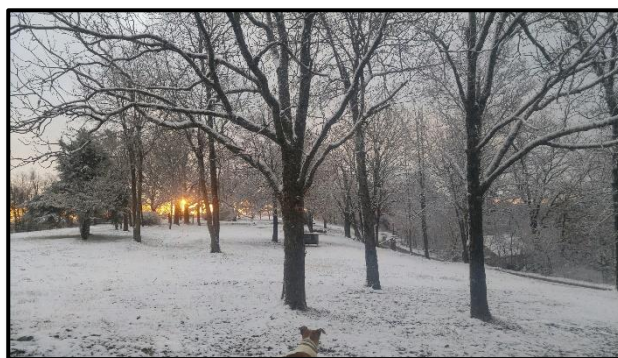
